Trafalgar PAC November 8, 2022 Principal's Report

Cell phones We are still working on getting all of our students to place their cell phones in our cell phone hotels. We continue to see progress in this area and really notice a difference in engagement when the phones are put away.

Outside recess and lunch Similar to what we have done in our elementary schools, students and supervising staff will be outside for our morning break (maximum 17 minutes outside) and lunch break (maximum 27 minutes outside). The fresh air and space are good for us even if it is cold.

Student affordability fund The Ministry of Education has provided funding to school districts to make some of the costs of school more affordable for families. The fund is designed to improve students' access to nutritional food/meals at school and directly offset costs to families such as school supplies and other cost pressures. We are looking at reducing all hot lunch costs for the remainder of the school year by subsidizing costs from this fund. We also have some transportation , school sports and hardship funds to administer as well.

Reporting in November November 15 is deadline for a written report on literacy, numeracy and learning requirements (Careers) to be sent home by classroom teachers. This is the first of 4 reports during the year plus a fifth at the end of June. A second report out to parents will happen during parent-teacher conferences on November 16 and 17. Some teachers are offering a few spots outside of those days but most are on the Wednesday and Thursday of that week. Dismissal times and busses will be one hour earlier than normal.

Last Day for LLE Q1 November 9 is the last day for quarter one Life Long Explorations. Students will get their second quarter schedules on the same day.

Yearbook for Trafalgar We have surveyed our parents (and students) around their interest in a Trafalgar yearbook for 22/23. We have 177 parents who have responded to the survey so far but we would like a few more parents (along with their child) to respond before we make firm plans.

Budget SD8 requires schools to provide their budgets, spending and reserve funds to their PACs on annual basis. Principal Mushumanski will provide full details at the December PAC meeting.
