Configuration For Learning Mr. Mush and staff are looking at different options and models for grade 9 learners for next year. It might be time to look at a timetable that resembles the high school model more than an elementary model. Students could see a different teacher for Math, Science, Social Studies and English. Once we have had a larger discussion at an upcoming staff meeting, Mr. Mush will reach out to grade 8 parents for some input.

Staff Book Club Some Trafalgar staff are reading Kids These Days by Dr. Jody Carrington and meeting to discuss what we could use in our classrooms. It is all about human connections and how important they are in our world and in our schools. Three breakfast meetings are scheduled to discuss the book.PBIS at Trafalgar Staff will start looking at Positive Behavioral Intervention and Supports for Trafalgar. This system approach informs students of what is expected where and when. It is used widely in schools across the globe and has been shown to improve student achievement and belonging even in the toughest of schools.
