 - C. Grade 9 Basketball (Caroline St-Germain and other parents) general request for funding of travel and accomodations for SD8 teacher sponsor to possible tournaments in the Okanagan and Vancouver and purchase of Home/Away reversible Jerseys no specific dollar amount. Tim confirmed the Jersey's are already covered by request #1. Team has 25/30 students. Plans are uncertain at this point so no real idea of budget or funds needed. Tim advised generally that each TOC day costs the school around \$400. Hotels and meals are around \$250 per day with variability.
