Jackie asked for an additional \$1500 from PAC for band trip travel.

Lorien suggested selling spirit wear. The band or PAC could sell spirit wear as a fundraiser. The school cannot sell anything for profit. Jess will check with Tim about this idea.

# 8. Basketball Committee Report (if any) (Emma)

New uniforms have arrived, are reversible. The Gr. 9 boys are very happy with them.

Funds have trickled in slowly from the bottle drive (about \$1000). The money is going into the school's account.

Waiting to see if more fundraisers will be needed.

Multiple raffle box pages can be run by the PAC. Each group needs to get a separate license (through PAC).

There was a request for a banner that can travel with teams (all teams).

#### 9. New business:

A. Jersey needs – request for advice on school wide needs (Patricia)

Jess will discuss school-wide jersey needs with Tim.

Lorien will draft a letter to the district from the PAC about funds for

support for school jerseys.

Jon notes that we will need to keep other groups in mind in terms of how much PAC can help other basketball team.

### B. Student Clubs (Bruce)

The club environment suffered during COVID, and lost momentum. Maybe some of the PAC's excess funds could go towards reinvigorating the club environment, giving kids more options for activities. Would be an opportunity to spread the funds around a bit more and get some momentum back.

Tomorrow at the staff meeting, Jess will let staff know that some funds may be available. There may be an ask for paint for repainting school mural. Or LLE teachers might need help with supplies for their classes. Gaming money cannot be used for curriculum, but general PAC funds / community account can be.

A comprehensive list of school clubs would be helpful for the PAC.
