 Discussion: None of the trees will be saved. The PAC could set up a pergola (or something similar) to provide shade around the grounds.
 We could look into applying for grants to replace trees. The \$10,000 might not cover the cost of very many trees.

Tim graciously thanked the PAC members for their support over the year.

6. DPAC Report – Jon

Due to a mixup, Jon didn't make it to the meeting. Communication from the DPAC has been poor. These things are cyclical. We are hoping for better days in the future.

7. Band Committee Report – Jackie

We still need to raise \$2723 to cover our costs. We made just over \$1000 from the yard sale. Tomorrow is the concert, also Fisherman's Friend fundraiser, one more 50/50.

We cheered Jackie, who went above and beyond with both the fundraising and chaperoning for the Sun Peaks trip.

Bruce made a motion that PAC's contribution to band be equal to the donation to the boys's basketball team (To date, PAC gave \$4400 to basketball, and \$3900 to band), provided that the band travel account is in a deficit position after all the fundraising and funding sources have been finalized for the school year.

So PAC would increase its contribution to the band to \$500, dependent on the outcome of the current fundraising efforts.
